CARCASS CLASS ENTRY INFORMATION AND TERMS

1. Entry fee is \$50 per consignment. One entry per consignor in each class.
2. All entries will be mouthed when they arrive at Western Buffalo Company on the slaughter date. On that date, only bulls with all their baby teeth will be accepted and heifers can not have more than two permanent teeth.
3. **PLEASE NOTE:** The minimum weight for bull carcasses will be 550 pounds. The minimum weight for heifer carcasses will be 435 pounds. Please keep this in mind as you select animals to bring to the contest. Carcasses not meeting the minimum weight requirements will be disqualified from the contest and there will be no entry fee refund. Western Buffalo Company has agreed to purchase those carcasses at an approximate price of \$2.45 for bulls and \$2.35 for heifers, depending on the market, or the consignor may pay the processing fee and take the meat home. All other terms and conditions relating to the carcasses will still apply to those that are disqualified from the contest.
4. No health papers are needed on the animals participating in the Carcass Class.
5. **Bulls and heifers will be delivered live to Western Buffalo Company in Rapid City, SD on Thursday, January 7, 2010 only.** Please be aware that, given the work schedule at Western Buffalo Company, the association is trying to work within a set time frame. We will be able to process all entries in one day.
6. South Dakota State University and a State Inspector will be on hand to oversee the testing of the meat cuts. All cuts will be trimmed to 1/4" fat cover and the ground buffalo will be tested for fat content and a sliding scale for value of product will be set up.
7. All buffalo will be boxed separately and frozen. Cut test sheets on each carcass will be developed showing how the cuts or group of cuts affect the bottom line.
8. The winner of the Carcass Class will be the buffalo that yields the most percentage of profit.
9. The ribeye from ALL carcass class entries is donated and will be used as the main entree at the DTBA Awards Banquet during our Winter Conference. The cost of the ribeyes from ALL the entries is put into one lump sum and then equally deducted from each consignor's check. If you want the meat back from your animals, be aware that the ribeye area will not be included. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS!
10. All entries will have the option of paying a modest processing fee and taking their carcass home or Western Buffalo Company will purchase the carcass s outlined above.
11. Consignors will be asked to provide a history of entries, to include items such as days on feed, type of feed, genetics, weaning weight, last available weight at home, etc. Please keep this in mind as you prepare your entries. All entries will be photographed at Western Buffalo Company prior to slaughter.
12. Class winners will receive points that go toward the BHBC Producer of the Year award.
13. Entry fee is not refundable. Consignors must be in good standing with the association to enter.
14. There will be a Consignor's Meeting at 3 p.m. on Friday, February 5, 2010 at the Ramkota Hotel in Rapid City, SD. Your attendance is encouraged at this meeting.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

1. Negative Tuberculosis test (caudal fold) on all animals. Test must have been done within 25 days of sale date.
2. Negative Brucellosis test on all animals. Test must have been done within 25 days of sale date.
3. Negative Anaplasmosis test on all animals. Test must have been done within 25 days of sale date.
4. All females MUST be calthood vaccinated for Brucellosis. Show tag numbers, metal tag numbers and BV tattoo numbers must correctly coincide on the Health Certificate.
5. All animals must be treated with INJECTABLE ivermec. **IMPORTANT:** Animals coming from south of the southern Wyoming-Nebraska-Iowa borders must be injected within 10 days of the show date. Animals coming from north of these southern borders must be injected within 25 days of the show date.
6. ALL yearling bulls MUST be semen checked and certified fertile.
7. All two year old heifers must be certified at least 90 days pregnant.
8. All yearling heifers must be certified OPEN.
9. **PLEASE NOTE!** A consignor bringing in two year old bred heifers will be required to have a Teeth Affidavit Form filled out and signed by their veterinarian indicating that the veterinarian checked the animal between December 21, 2009 and February 3, 2010 and the animal had no more than four fully erupted adult teeth at the time of inspection. Two year old animals who arrive at the show grounds and do not have a completed Teeth Affidavit Form will not be unloaded and the consignor will forfeit any entry fees for those animals. Any two year old animal that has more than four fully erupted adult teeth will be immediately disqualified and the consignor will forfeit any entry fees.
10. Three copies must be furnished with the original health certificate. Separate health certificates are required for each animal. Top 5 Bull Calves, Top 10 Heifer Calves and Top 5 Yearling Heifers can be on one certificate with three copies.
11. *Animals WILL NOT be unloaded if the health certificates do not meet ALL of the above requirements. NO EXCEPTIONS! Pregnancy test, semen test, ivermec and mouthing must be written across the bottom of each health certificate with the date and signature of your veterinarian. Keep your test paperwork with you in case it is needed.*
12. Any animal entered in the Black Hills Buffalo Classic Showcase can not have entered another show and sale in the six months prior to the Black Hills Buffalo Classic event.

THE SHOW/SALE COMMITTEE HIGHLY RECOMMENDS 4-WAY TESTING OF SHOW ANIMALS

CONSIGNOR MEETING

There will be a Show and Sale/Carcass Class consignor's meeting held on Friday, February 5, 2010 at 3 p.m. at the Ramkota Hotel in Rapid City in the Executive Lounge.

HORNS

Dehorned animals accepted are yearling and two year old heifers ONLY. All others must have either two good horns or broken horns which have fully healed. We will work with you in case of a broken horn while at the show. Severe bleeders cannot enter the sale ring.

EAR TAGS

Show tags, NBA Source Verification tags, metal vaccine/tag and registration button are the only tags acceptable in the buffalo's ear. **Consignors will be responsible for applying the show tags in the LEFT ear.** This must be done before the animals will be allowed to unload. Any animal that shows up with an extra tag will be charged \$50 to take the tag out.

SEE OTHER SIDE FOR ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

ENTRY LIMITS AND DEADLINES

Maximum of twenty (20) head for all single heifer calf, bull calf and 2 year old bred heifer classes; maximum of thirty (30) head for yearling bull and yearling heifer classes and twenty (20) entries for the Top Five and Top Ten classes. Two (2) head per consignor per single class and one (1) entry per consignor per Top Five or Top Ten class until January 18, 2010, providing pen space available. If a class is not filled by this date, you will be allowed a three (3) head per consignor per single class and two (2) pens of Top Five and Top Ten per consignor until the classes are filled. Waiting list will apply based on the earliest postal dates on entries. Limits per consignor will be enforced. Limits per class are flexible depending upon overall entries and available pen space.

ENTRY ACCEPTANCE NOTIFICATION

All consignors will be notified as soon as possible as to which entries have been accepted into the 2010 Black Hills Buffalo Classic Show and Sale. BHBC Show and Sale ear tags will mail as soon as your entries have been processed.

ARRIVAL AND LOADOUT TIME

Animals will be unloaded at the Pennington County Events Center at the Central States Fairgrounds. Pens will be located just south of the Event Center. Maps will be included in your packet with ear tags. Animals may be unloaded on Thursday, February 4 from 12:00 noon until 4:30 p.m. and on Friday, February 5 from 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon. Load out after the sale will begin at the conclusion of the sale, as soon as payment and health forms are in order and continue until dark. On Monday, February 8, loadout will take place from 7:30 a.m. until 12:00 noon. All animals MUST be off the grounds by 12:00 noon on Monday, February 8. Any animals left in the pens after dark on Sunday evening are there at the owner's risk.

CLASSIC PRODUCER AWARD & ROOKIE OF THE YEAR (Determined on a point system)

Points for Gold, Silver and Bronze awards will be given on a 3-2-1 basis. A Grand Champion will earn one extra bonus point. A Reserve Champion will earn one-half point. The Reality-Based Carcass Class and Young Guns Yearling Bull Challenge awards will count towards the Classic Producer's Award and will use the same point system as outlined above.

There will only be one Producer of the Year and Rookie of the Year award given out in a respective year. Should there be a tie for either award, the show and sale committee and the DTBA board of directors will use the following criteria to break the tie: Honorable Mentions, depth of class and number of classes entered. All decisions of the judges, the show and sale committee and the board of directors will be final.

LIABILITY

1. The consignor assumes all responsibilities in regards to, but not limited to, the above terms and conditions of this show and sale. The DTBA acts only as agents and will assume NO responsibility in the event of injury or death to any animal or for any discrepancy between the buyers and the consignors.
2. The Judges and/or Show Committee reserve the right to disqualify and remove any animal(s) from the Show and Sale if the animal(s) appear to be of undesirable quality or of the wrong age. A chute will also be on hand. Committee decisions are final.
3. Black Hills Buffalo Classic Show and Sale Committee reserves the right to inspect any animals and may ultimately disqualify any animal for any reason they deem necessary. All decisions of the show and sale committee are final.
4. Disqualified animals must be removed from the show grounds immediately.

NOTE ABOUT THE SIFTING COMMITTEE

The sifting committee is appointed by the DTBA Board of Directors and the show chairman. Members of the sifting committee cannot have animals consigned to the show when serving in this capacity. The sifting committee will have no tolerance for animals that are undesirable. Any undesirable animals will be loaded back on to the consignor's trailer. It will be the responsibility of the consignor to provide feed and care for his/her animal(s). These animals will not be judged in the show and will not be allowed to sell in the sale ring during the auction.

YOUNG GUNS YEARLING BULL CHALLENGE ENTRY INFORMATION AND TERMS

1. There will be a \$600 entry fee per calf. Limit of two entries per consignor. Entry fee is non-refundable. \$550 of each entry fee will go to the hosting ranch with the remaining \$50 going to the Dakota Territory Buffalo Association. This fee includes entry into the following years Black Hills Buffalo Classic Show and Sale.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR CALVES BEING BROUGHT IN FOR THE CHALLENGE

A. Health Certificate and any necessary testing/paperwork for animals being brought into South Dakota from the consignor's home state.

EAR TAGS

A. Show tags, NBA Source Verification tags, metal vaccine/tag and registration button are the only tags acceptable in the buffalo's ear. Upon receipt of your entry, you will be sent TWO ear tags for each calf entered in the Young Guns class. All calves entered into this class will be double tagged to ensure that they can be identified throughout the course of the year testing period. One tag to be placed in each ear prior to delivery at the show grounds.

ARRIVAL TIME

Animals will be unloaded at the Pennington County Events Center at the Central States Fairgrounds. Maps will be included in your packet with ear tags. Animals may be unloaded on Thursday, February 4 from 12:00 noon until 4:30 p.m. and on Friday, February 5 from 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon.

2. Animals entered into the 2010 -2011 Young Guns Bull Challenge will be delivered to the Pennington County Events Center during the 2010 Black Hills Buffalo Classic Show and Sale. The animals will then be transported to the host ranch from this location at the conclusion of the event. The calves will not be judged at any time during the delivery period. The challenge will begin upon arrival at the host ranch.

3. Consignors will have the option to pull their animal out of the contest should it become injured or if it is determined that the animal has not met the minimum standards to be sold at the BHBC sale. In the case of an entry being pulled from the contest, there will be no refund of the entry fee and the animal will not be sold at the sale.

4. All data collected on the animals during the contest will be provided to both the consignor and buyer of said animal at the completion of the contest.

5. At the end of the one year period, all animals will return to compete at the Black Hills Buffalo Classic Show and Sale as yearlings. All animals will be tested as per the rules for the Black Hills Buffalo Classic. All testing/tagging, etc. will be done by the host ranch before the animals are returned for the show. The Young Guns Bull Challenge yearlings will be judged as a separate class from the other yearling bulls entered in the show.

6. Criteria for judging the Young Guns Bull Challenge will be divided into three categories. One third of the criteria will be based on the animal's grass gains; one third will be based on the animal's finish gains and one third will be based on the live animal judging. The winner of the Young Guns Bull Challenge will be the bull that has the highest combined score based on those three elements.

7. Placings in the Young Guns Bull Challenge will be to third place. Trophies will be awarded to the top three placing animals.

8. ALL entries will be sold at the Black Hills Buffalo Classic Sale as part of the Young Guns Bull Challenge class. Proceeds from the sale of the animal, minus the current sale commission, will go to the consignor of the animal.

9. Entry fee is not refundable. Consignors must be in good standing with the association to enter.

10. There will be a Consignor's Meeting at 3 p.m. on Friday, February 5, 2010 at the Ramkota Hotel in Rapid City, SD. Your attendance is encouraged at this meeting. There will also be a scheduled time on Saturday, February 6 during the day for anyone interested in this class to get more information and for current and potential consignors to discuss improvements and/or additions to this class.
