#### MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT CONTINUED

Without Alex, his family, friends, and employees, the sale may not have happened. He has put in countless hours and resources to ensure a safe environment for these animals and allow the producers to view them prior to the sale. I cannot express my gratitude enough for Alex and all the others that make this association what it is today. I also want to thank Alex for the years of service on the board. His attention to detail, analyzing situations, and bringing in a different point of view has been extremely valuable to the board and many of its members over the years. Thanks Alex?
